## MCCC TO HOST TRIBUTE TO THE EAGLES, ZZ TOP AND CCR

## Less Than 190 Tickets Remain; VIP Tickets Sold Out

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College will present "American Rock and Roll: A Tribute to the Eagles, ZZ Top and CCR," on Friday, Jan. 21 at 7:30 p.m. in the La-Z-Boy Center, Meyer Theater.

The La-Z-Boy Center is located on MCCC's Main Campus at 1555 S. Raisinville Rd. in Monroe.

The American Rock and Roll Show will feature two hours of recreated, Top 10 classic rock hits.

The Long Run will replicate the harmonies and instrumentation of the Eagles, Fandango will reinvent the ZZ Top experience, and Bradley Ford will rock the Meyer Theater with an impersonation of John Fogerty, former lead vocalist, lead singer and primary songwriter for Creedence Clearwater Revival.

The Long Run is a Los Angeles tribute that has been recreating the music of the Eagles since 1999. The band performs a catalog of Eagles classics along with selected hits from the solo careers of various members of the Eagles.

Fandango debuted in 1996 when the band opened for Blue Oyster Cult, and has since toured the U.S. and Japan with its ZZ Top-tribute music. The band's music, costumes, makeup and

visual effects help to replicate the live experience of a ZZ Top concert.

For more than 15 years, Bradley Ford has performed a recreation of Creedence Clearwater Revival's career, as well as John Fogerty's solo efforts. Ford has toured across the U.S., Canada, Europe and Asia.

Tickets for the American Rock and Roll are \$25 for reserved seating. Less than 190 tickets remain. VIP seating is sold out.
