**MCCC BLOOD DRIVE ORGANIZERS STRIVE
FOR RECORD NUMBER OF DONATIONS**

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College's bi-annual Red Cross Blood Drive is set for Oct. 26, and organizers are setting their sights on a campus record for donations.

The blood drive will take place in the dining room of the Audrey M. Warrick Student Services/Administration Building on the Main Campus, which is located at 1555 S. Raisinville Rd. in Monroe. Donations can be made between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

The blood drive set a record last October with 70 units of blood donated, a number that was topped in MCCC's February drive, which brought in 83 units.

As for this year, organizers are hopeful to break yet another record.

Student Government member Shana Kritzer said she feels confident that the drive will be able to meet and surpass the goal of 63 units. MCCC Campus/Community Events Coordinator Tom Ryder said that he hopes to see 100 people donate this semester.

All donors will receive an aluminum water bottle and be entered into a drawing to football tickets to the Ohio State University-University of Michigan football game.
