### **FREE, 40-HOUR BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS TRAINING SESSION TO BE HELD AT MCCC**

MONROE, Mich. – A free, 40-hour business training session will be hosted by Monroe County Community College in partnership with Macomb Community College May 9-13.

This session is for unemployed or underemployed individuals who hold a bachelor's degree and have at least five years of employment experience, as well as individuals who are veterans of the armed services.

“Business Communications after Being Downsized,” will train participants on how to communicate effectively, strengthen interpersonal relationships, tap unrecognized potential, manage stress and handle fast-changing workplace conditions.

The training will run from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day in Room 257/258 of the La-Z-Boy Center on the college's Main Campus.

Participants will be equipped with a higher level of confidence, improved communication skills, a more positive attitude, human relations and motivational skills, and enhanced teamwork for more creative solutions.

Although participants could expect to pay \$1,000 to 1,500 for a class with such depth, the session is made free through a grant from the Department of Labor.
