## MCCC TO HOST DUAL ENROLLMENT INFO SESSIONS

MONROE and TEMPERANCE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College has scheduled two dual enrollment information sessions in the month of April.

Dual enrollment is a program that allows high school students to attend MCCC classes and earn college credit while still attending high school.

The first session will take place on Wednesday, April 13 from 6:30-7:30 p.m. in Room Z-259/260 of the La-Z-Boy Center, located on the college's Main Campus at 1555 S. Raisinville Rd. in Monroe.

The second session will be held Thursday, April 21 from 6 to 7 p.m. in Room 8 of the Whitman Center, located at 7777 Lewis Ave. in Temperance.

All Monroe County high school students and their parents or guardians – as well as teachers, counselors and administrators – are invited to attend.

The session will highlight the steps necessary for dual enrollment, recommended courses, what students can expect from their college classes, and the pros and cons of dual enrollment.
