JOSHUA MYERS NAMED COORDINATOR OF DEVELOPMENT AND EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

MONROE, Mich. – Joshua Myers will join Monroe County Community College as coordinator of development and external affairs on May 9.

Since 2005, he has served as field representative for U.S. Rep. John D. Dingell (D-Dearborn).

Myers will assist in the coordination of all fundraising activities in support of MCCC's ongoing needs and priorities under the supervision of the vice president of administration/executive director of The Foundation at MCCC.

In addition, he will assist in the development, implementation and evaluation of the college's comprehensive external relations program. He will provide support for the college's legislative relations program on the local, state and federal levels and assist the director of marketing in the development, management and evaluation of the college's public and community relations program.

As Dingell's field representative, Myers has served as a conduit between community organizations and legislative staff in Washington, D.C. to bring about legislation and reform. He has planned and coordinated events in advance of staffing the congressman while he is in the 15th Congressional District and served as a surrogate for Dingell at meetings, events and throughout the community.

Myers managed numerous multi-million dollar federal projects within Monroe and Wayne counties, developed strategies for communicating Dingell's legislative agenda, worked with non-profit organizations to ensure sustainability and resource development, and fostered and maintained relationships with local elected officials, community leaders and constituent groups.

Prior to joining Dingell's staff, he worked as a staff assistant for U.S. Sen. Carl Levin (D-Mich.), from 2003-2005.

Last year, Myers was named the Monroe County Community College Supporter of the Year.

He currently serves on the boards of the MCCC Alumni Association, River Raisin Centre for the Arts and the War of 1812 Bicentennial Steering Committee.

Myers holds a bachelor's degree in international relations from Michigan State University and an associate degree from MCCC.
