### **MCCC AWARDS THE JOYCE HOAGLAND EBY SCHOLARSHIP**

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College has awarded the Joyce Hoagland Eby Scholarship to Christine Angela Skye Keskeny of Monroe. The \$1,200 scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, and fees.

Keskeny is a 2008 Monroe High School graduate and daughter to Terrie J. Carden. She has three siblings, Glenn Harbour Jr., Robbin Keskeny and Leslie Keskeny.
