MCCC BOARD APPROVES CONTRACT EXTENSIONS FOR FACULTY, MAINTENANCE ASSOCIATIONS

MONROE, Mich. – At a special meeting today, the Monroe County Community College Board of Trustees approved respective one-year contract extensions for the MCCC Faculty Association and Maintenance Association.

The 2010-12 Master Agreement between the Faculty Association and the college, which was set to expire on Aug. 24, 2012, has been extended through Aug. 23, 2013. The agreement covers the 67 full-time faculty positions at the college.

It includes the continuation of a freeze on existing wage rates; health insurance is unchanged. Faculty on steps 1-11 of the salary schedule will receive the next scheduled step increase in the 2012-13 fiscal year. Faculty on step 12 will receive a one-time, off-schedule payment of \$500.

The 2011-2013 Master Agreement between the college and the Maintenance Association, which covers the 20 full-time maintenance positions at the college and was set to expire on June 30, 2013, has been extended through June 30, 2014.

The agreement continues a freeze on existing wage rates for the maintenance staff and maintains existing health insurance. The agreement also includes a one-time, off schedule payment of \$500 in December 2013.

“These contract extensions are a significant recognition of the college, Faculty Association and Maintenance Association working together to continue to deal with these challenging economic times,” said MCCC president Dr. David Nixon.

“This decision honors the Board of Trustee’s continuing commitment to cost containment and long-standing tradition of fiscal responsibility at Monroe County Community College,” said chair William J. Bacarella Jr.

The college’s administration, support staff and maintenance staff have been under a wage freeze since 2008. The faculty has been under a wage freeze since 2009.
