## **WHITMAN CENTER TO HOST EXHIBITS AND PRESENTATIONS ON SPACE EXPLORATION**

MONROE, Mich. – Two free exhibits about the moon and solar system will be displayed at Monroe County Community College's Whitman Center from Aug. 25 to Sept. 28. The center will also host a presentation on Sept. 28 on NASA's explorations into space.

The Whitman Center is located at 7777 Lewis Ave. in Temperance.

Loaned from the Lunar and Planetary Institute of Houston, the exhibits explain how the characteristics and craters of the moon have aided in the understanding of the solar system and its creation.

They will be displayed in the Whitman Center lobby for free viewing during regular business hours, which are 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday.

On Sept. 28, a free presentation will be held from 7 to 8 p.m. in Room 9 of the Whitman Center. Dr. Laura J. Megeath, coordinator of the Appold Planetarium at Lourdes University in Sylvania, Ohio, will lead a discussion about various NASA missions that have probed the mysteries of our solar system, such as the Hubble Space Telescope. No registration is required.
