Special Board Meeting Moved Up

MONROE, Mich. – One of the five finalists for the position of president at Monroe County Community College, Dr. Renay Scott, has withdrawn her name from consideration.

Dr. Scott was scheduled for a public forum and board interview on May 23. Both have been cancelled.

The other four finalists are scheduled for public forums and board interviews on May 21-22.

The MCCC special board meeting regarding the selection of the new president originally scheduled for Thursday, May 23 at 6:30 p.m. has been moved up to Wednesday, May 22 at 7:45 p.m.

The remaining presidential finalists include Dr. Carlee Drummer, executive director of college advancement and executive director of the educational foundation at Oakton Community College, Des Plaines and Skokie, Ill.; Dr. Karen Hays, vice president, academic and student affairs at Middlesex
