MCCC TO HOST 3rd ANNUAL CAREER AND OPPORTUNITY EXPO

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College will host the third-annual Career and Opportunity Expo on Friday, April 12 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The expo, which is free and open to the public, will be held in the Gerald Welch Health Education Building on MCCC's Main Campus, which is located at 1555 South Raisinville Rd. in Monroe.

Last year, the event was attended by 400 job seekers and featured 88 exhibitors/employers.

Barry Kinsey, director of workforce development and chair of the expo, said the expo will bring together students, MCCC alumni, colleges and universities, employers and community members, with an emphasis on returning service members.

Professional dress is required for those who plan to attend. While resumes are not required, they are encouraged.
