ANNOUNCES FINALISTS FOR PRESIDENT

Open Forums to Meet Candidates to be Held on Campus

MONROE, Mich. – The Monroe County Community College Board of Trustees has announced five finalists for the position of president.

The college is seeking a successor to Dr. David Nixon, who will retire at the end of his current employment contract on July 31.

The finalists are, in alphabetical order: **Dr. Carlee Drummer**, executive director of college advancement and executive director of the educational foundation at Oakton Community College, Des Plaines and Skokie, Ill.; **Dr. Karen Hays**, vice president, academic and student affairs at Middlesex County College in Edison, N.J.; **Dr. Kojo Quartey**, provost and chief academic officer at the City Colleges of Chicago; **Dr. Renay Scott**, vice president and provost of Owens Community College in Toledo; and **Suzanne Wetzel**, vice president of administration and executive director of The Foundation at Monroe County Community College.

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The finalists were selected from a larger group of candidates interviewed by the Presidential Search Advisory Committee and recommended to the Board of Trustees. The committee is chaired by William H. Braunlich, vice chair of the Board of Trustees, and includes both college and community representatives.

Faculty, staff, students and the community will have an opportunity to meet the candidates during open forums to be held on campus in May, and the candidates will be interviewed by members of the Board of Trustees.

The open forums will be for one hour in length.

In addition to the open forums and interviews, there will be meetings with the finalists scheduled with the Board of Trustees and the college leadership and community, including representatives from administration, faculty, support staff and maintenance employees; student government; and The Foundation.

Information on dates, times and locations for the open forums will be released once details are finalized.

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
