MCCC PRESIDENT TO PRESENT ON SITUATION IN NIGERIA

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College President Dr. Kojo A. Quartey will make a presentation on the situation in Nigeria on Monday from noon-1 p.m. in the Dining Room of the Audrey M. Warrick Student Services/Administration Building.

The presentation, entitled “What the Heck is Going on in Nigeria?” is free and open to the public. It is part of the Culture and Current Affairs Speakers Series sponsored by MCCC.

According to a FOX News report yesterday, Pentagon officials are still feverishly trying to rescue nearly 300 Nigerian school girls from Boko Haram, an African jihadist group whose murderous campaign against its Christian countrymen continues unabated. The cause gripped the globe less than a month ago, when the horrific detail of the girls’ abduction was followed by a vow from Boko Haram’s leader to sell the young women.

The situation has only become more dire as time has passed.
