MCCC TO HOST PANEL DISCUSSION ON RACE RELATIONS

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College will host a panel discussion on race relations on Tuesday from noon-1 p.m. in the Dining Room of the Audrey M. Warrick Student Services/Administration Building.

The presentation, entitled “Race Relations: An Honest Conversation,” is free and open to the public. It will be hosted by MCCC President Kojo A. Quartey.

The topic of race relations has been in the national headlines recently as a result the scandal revolving around the owner of the Los Angeles Clippers of the National Basketball Association. The NBA is attempting to strip Donald Sterling of his ownership of the franchise, and the league’s Board of Governors is slated to vote June 3 whether to force Sterling and his wife, Shelly, to sell the Clippers after Sterling was recorded last month making racist comments. Sterling was banned for life from the NBA shortly after the story broke.

The presentation is part of the Culture and Current Affairs Speakers Series sponsored by MCCC, which features MCCC faculty, staff, students and alumni with expertise on a variety of cultural, political or social topics of importance and interest at the present time.
