Free and Open to the Public: Crime prevention is a way of life that offers greater security and peace of mind. When you practice basic personal safety measures, you must always be aware of your surroundings, whether at home or away. You should maximize your home security by surveying and correcting security weaknesses in your residence. This seminar is designed to point out security flaws in your residence and help you correct them. The objectives of this seminar are to: 1) Obtain citizen involvement in community safety by discouraging and preventing crime, and 2) Increase effective reporting to local law enforcement.
