MCCC AWARDS THE PHILIP IOTT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Monroe County Community College has awarded the Philip Iott Memorial Scholarship to Ryley Bourbina. The scholarship is in the amount of \$1,200 and is to be used for tuition, fees and books.
