MCCC AND MCISD TO HOST
‘ACTIVE SHOOTER RESPONSE’ TRAINING

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College and Monroe County Intermediate School District will host an Active Shooter Response Training Instructor Course.

The course, taught by the ALICE Training Institute (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate), will be held on Oct. 7 and 8, from 8 a.m.-4 p.m. in the La-Z-Boy Center rooms 259 and 260. The cost is \$495 per person.

The two-day course is designed to teach law enforcement and administrators proactive survival strategies in violent intruder and active shooter situations. Topics covered will be background statistics and information, response concepts, live scenario drills and instructor strategies. Training is meant to bridge the gap between a violent event beginning and law enforcement arrival.
