### ***Grape Crushing and De-stemming 'While You Wait' Part of Michigan Community Colleges Week***

MONROE, Mich. – In recognition of Michigan Community Colleges Week, Monroe County Community College will present the first-ever MCCC Bacchus Community Crush – grape crushing and de-stemming while you wait – on Sunday, Sept. 14

The event, which is free and open to the public, will take place from noon-3 p.m. in the MCCC Wine Lab, which is located in the West Technology Building on the college's Main Campus, 1555 S. Raisinville Rd., Monroe.

Donations will be accepted, and food prepared by MCCC culinary arts students will be available for purchase.
