**MCCC TO SCREEN ‘ON THE WATERFRONT’  
AS PART OF FREE CLASSIC MOVIE SERIES**

*Guest Speaker David Walsh to Discuss Political  
Atmosphere Surrounding Film’s Production and 1954 Release*

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College will screen the 1954 film “On the Waterfront” on Wednesday, Nov. 4 at 5:30 p.m., as part of its continuing, free classic movie series at the La-Z-Boy Center, Meyer Theater.

The La-Z-Boy Center is located on MCCC’s Main Campus at 1555 S. Raisinville Rd.

“On The Waterfront” is Elia Kazan’s gripping depiction of the struggle between dockworkers and their mob-controlled union in the early 1950s. The film won eight Oscars, including Marlon Brando’s first for best actor in a leading role.

David Walsh, arts editor for the World Socialist Website and author of the recently published book “The Sky Between the Leaves: Film Reviews, Essays and Interviews, 1992-2012,” will follow the showing of “On the Waterfront” with a discussion of the political atmosphere surrounding the film’s production and release.

According to his website, Walsh has been with the World Socialist Website since its launch in 1998. He is the author of hundreds of critical essays on contemporary arts and culture.
