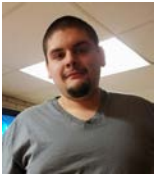

MONROE, Mich. – The foundation at Monroe County Community College has awarded the Midway Products – Lyman E. Hoyt Memorial Scholarship to **Jakob Stanard**. The \$1,100 scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, and fees.

In addition, student must maintain full-time enrollment status of 12 credit hours or more, must have and maintain a 2.5 grade point average or higher during their scholarship year and demonstrate financial need. Preference will be given to a Monroe County resident or a child of Midway Products, Inc. employee.
