DIRECTOR OF LEARNING RESOURCES

Under the direction of the Vice President of Student and Information Services, the Director of Learning Resources shall:

- 1. Plan, organize, administer, and evaluate the programs and operations of the Learning Resources Center including the Learning Assistance Lab (LAL).
- 2. Supervise and evaluate the activities and performance of the library and LAL staff.
- 3. Assist in screening candidates for positions in Learning Resources and make recommendations regarding the selection.
- 4. Encourage the effective use of the resources, services, facilities and equipment of the Learning Resources Center, including the ITV room, through cooperative efforts with faculty, administrators and staff.
- 5. Assist the faculty and administration in the planning, evaluation, and selection of learning resources materials, educational technologies, equipment and delivery systems.
- 6. Collaborate with faculty in the implementation of Internet and other technology-mediated distance learning courses, commensurate with administrative responsibilities.
- 7. Work cooperatively with appropriate administrators and the faculty in planning new programs and courses to determine the impact on present learning resources services and equipment.
- 8. Keep the Vice President of Student and Information Services informed through appropriate reports, of the utilization, operation and needs of the Learning Resources Center.
- 9. Prepare the Learning Resources Center budgets with input from the appropriate areas and approve expenditures.
- 10. Evaluate and acknowledge gifts to the Learning Resources Center.
- 11. Keep informed of current efforts and trends in the effective use of electronic and print resources, and make appropriate recommendations to the Vice President of Student and Information Services.
- 12. Provide reference and bibliographic services, and ADA accommodations services as assigned, commensurate with administrative responsibilities.
- 13. Provide administration and direction for all activities of the LAL including assessment, testing, tutoring, supplemental instruction, and counseling services.
- 14. Keep informed of current legislation and trends in providing accommodations for students with disabilities and provide institutional administration through the LAL.
- 15. Serve as an ex-officio member of the Learning Resources Committee.
- 16. Such other duties as assigned by the Vice President of Student and Information Services.
