Course Description

This course is a continuation of French 151. There will be emphasis on aural and oral practices. Also, there will be a study of French contemporary life and reading selections. There will be instructional aids included. The primary purpose of this course is to have the students read and write the French language at a fluent elementary level, with comprehension at the same level. This course is a satisfier course for the Global Studies Degree Designation.

Course Outcomes

In order to evidence success in this course, the students will be able to:

- 1. Recognize the present and simple past verbal tenses in French
- 2. Demonstrate usage of elementary vocabulary
- 3. Identify vocabulary related to major unit studies
- 4. Memorize verb conjugations and usages
- 5. Identify various source materials used for cultural research
- 6. Demonstrate the ability to write short essays in the target language using present and simple past verbal tenses and previously studied vocabulary
- 7. Demonstrate the ability to use the target language in an elementary level conversation and/or reading material
- 8. Demonstrate the ability to use food related vocabulary in a classroom setting in oral and written presentations as if communicating in French in a restaurant setting
- 9. Demonstrate general knowledge of French culture relating to food including French cuisine terms and French cuisine preparation
- 10. Demonstrate the ability understand the general terms of French cuisine and the ability to order from a French menu in the target language while actually dining in a French restaurant

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
