## **How to Download an IRS Tax Transcript**

If you are unable to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to import your 2021 tax information onto your FAFSA from the IRS database and you do not have a copy of the 2021 tax return you submitted to the IRS, you are able to submit an IRS TAX RETURN TRANSCRIPT.

## Option 1:

You may request a copy of your 2021 IRS Tax Return Transcript on the IRS website at www.irs.gov.

- Go to <u>www.irs.gov</u>
- Click the box for Get Your Tax Record
- Click the box for Get Transcript Online
  - o You will be prompted to create an account
  - Make sure you download the 2021 Return Transcript

## Option 2:

You may call the IRS at 1-800-908-9946 and follow the prompts to request a Tax Return Transcript for 2021. You will receive a copy of your Return Transcript from the IRS in the mail within 5-10 business days.

## How to Request an IRS Non-Filing Letter

For individuals who have never filed a tax return with the IRS, complete the **IRS Form 4506-T** to request a copy of your 2021 IRS Non-Filing Letter.

- Complete lines 1 -4, following the instructions on page 2 of the form.
- Line 3: Enter the non-filer's street address and zip or postal code.
- Line 7: Select the checkbox on the right hand side for **Verification of Non-Filing**.
- Line 9: Year or period requested field, enter 12/31/2021.
- The non-filer must sign and date the form, and enter their telephone number.

Mail or fax the completed IRS Form 4506-T to the address or fax number provided on page 2 of the IRS Form 4506-T.

If the IRS Form 4506-T information is successfully validated, you can expect to receive a paper IRS Verification of Non-Filing letter at the address provided on your request within 10 -15 days.
