The Upward Bound summer program is right around the corner, and we are excited to have all three programs together on campus again this year! Planning for the UB summer program is still underway, but we ensure that it will be a beneficial experience for all our participants, even if the learning looks a little bit different than previous years.

Attending the Upward Bound summer program is beneficial for students in many ways. Here are just a few of the major benefits our students experience while attending the UB summer program on campus:

- Socializing- Our students have created stronger relationships with UB participants of their own program, but also have created meaningful friendships with UB students across the other districts. During a time when socialization has become increasingly difficult, this will be a great opportunity for students to interact with their peers in a positive environment.
- Developing skills useful for college life- During the UB summer program, students learn to navigate a college campus, take classes from lecture halls, interact with college staff and faculty, and even take a placement exam. These experiences help students develop independence and awareness that will make the transition to college easier when they start on their own.
- Avoiding the "summer slide"- Many studies show that students are likely to experience learning loss during summer vacation. The UB summer program allows students to continue engaging in learning experiences that are interactive and different from what they may experience in a traditional school setting. Students prepare for their upcoming courses in the fall, and many UB students who have participated in the summer program have said that it has helped them feel ahead of their peers when they started the next school year.
- Exploring new topics and interests- The UB summer program provides workshops to students that allow them to explore new topics and interests that may not be available to them at their home school. In previous summers, students have participated in workshops that discussed autos, acting, drawing, dancing, weather, mental health, poetry, sign language, and more!

POLICY ON FORMS & UPWARD BOUND FILE INFORMATION

If a student has not submitted a required form OR if the student has missing information in their Upward Bound File:

- 1. The student will not be allowed to participate in field trips and/or activities other than After School Tutoring until the required form/information is submitted.
- 2. The student's stipend check will be withheld until the required form/information is submitted.

Due to securing tickets and transportation for field trips and other activities, it is essential that we know how many students will be participating. For this reason, if the required permission slip has is not been submitted by the due date, the student's name will be placed on a waiting list and he/she may not be able to participate in the activity.
