

RAFFLES POLICY

Any raffle, drawing, lottery, or other game of chance sponsored by the College, College sponsored organizations, or any group or organization using College facilities or operating on College property must comply with all applicable laws and rules, including the Traxler-McCauley-Law-Bowman Bingo Act. MCL 432.101 et seq.

It is the responsibility of persons or organizations that are considering conducting a raffle, drawing, lottery, or other game of chance that will be sponsored by the College and/or held on College property to contact the Charitable Gaming Division of the Bureau of State Lottery for all qualification requirements and necessary licenses or approvals. The College may, at its discretion, require any person or organization planning to conduct a raffle, drawing, lottery, or other game of chance to be held on College property to provide proof of the necessary license or approval and may cancel the event if such proof is not provided to the College in advance of the event.
