**MCCC AWARDS THE THOMAS K. AND MARIE (COUSINEAU)  
KEEGAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College has awarded the Thomas K. and Marie (Cousineau) Keegan Memorial Scholarship to **Mitchell Lamour**. The \$1,000 scholarship is to be used for tuition, books and fees.

**Lamour**, of Monroe, is a 2015 graduate of St. Mary Catholic Central High School and is pursuing a Criminal Justice degree at MCCC. He was involved with Detroit Edison's Help the Osprey Movement. He is the son of Brian Lamour and Tamiko Lamour and brother to McKenzie and Andrew Lamour.
