**THE FOUNDATION AT MCCC AWARDS THE PFC. DENNIS J. MILLER JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

MONROE, Mich. – The Foundation at Monroe County Community College has awarded the Pfc. Dennis J. Miller Jr. Memorial Scholarship to **Jordan Stumpmier**. The scholarship of \$1,000 is to be used for tuition, fees and books.
