THE FOUNDATION AT MCCC AWARDS THE MCCC ALUMNI FAMILY MEMBER SCHOLARSHIP

MONROE, Mich. – The Foundation at Monroe County Community College has awarded the MCCC Alumni Family Member Scholarship to **Dominic Bowman**. The \$2,500 scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, fees and essential supplies.

Bowman, of Monroe, is a 2021 graduate of Mason Senior High School. He plans to take computer engineering, computer science, business and math classes at MCCC. To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must be a Monroe County resident, a U.S. citizen, a Monroe County high school graduate, and an immediate relative (child or spouse) of an MCCC graduate or student who earned 24 or more credits at MCCC. Additionally, a student must maintain full-time enrollment status of 12 credit hours or more. Special consideration will be given to a relative of an MCCC Alumni Association member in good standing.
