**Nelson**, of Newport, is a 2021 graduate of Airport High School. He will be studying welding technology while at MCCC. To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must enroll in an occupational program of study with the intent to complete a program of study at MCCC and immediately enter the workforce, must be a full-time student defined as twelve (12) billable contact hours or more, must be a resident of and graduated from high school in Monroe County, Michigan, and must have a grade point average of 2.8 or higher. Preference is given to students graduating from Dundee Community Schools.
