MONROE, Mich. – The Foundation at Monroe County Community College has awarded the Sonya Kay Brett Business and Computer Information Systems Endowed Memorial Scholarship to **Lucas Goins** and **Alliyah Trim**. Each \$1,700 scholarship is to be used for tuition, fees and books.

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must be enrolled in either a business or computer information systems program, have completed 24 credit hours or more and have a GPA of 2.8 or above. Also, the student must maintain full-time student status during the scholarship year, which is defined as 12 credit hours.
