THE FOUNDATION AT MCCC AWARDS THE GWENDOLYN M. JACOB MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

MONROE, Mich. – The Foundation at Monroe County Community College has awarded the Gwendolyn M. Jacob Memorial Scholarship to **Katie Kowicki**. The \$2,850 scholarship is to be used for tuition, books and fees.
