MONROE, Mich. – The Foundation at Monroe County Community College has awarded the John and Violet Mueller Scholarship to **Elizabeth Dyson** and **Zoe Messer**. Each \$1,900 scholarship is to be used for tuition, fees and books.

To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must be a graduate of Jefferson High School and a resident of Monroe County, Mich. In addition, students must maintain at least part-time enrollment of

six credit hours or more, and must have and maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or higher during their scholarship year.
